

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Rotary International is providing scholarships to African Medical Physics PhD students for a graduation commitment to serve their local communities, one year for each year of scholarship.

Medical Physics is a medical specialty supporting radiation oncology, radiology, and nuclear medicine, and is disproportionately lacking in Nigeria.

The Rotary e-Club of Greater Nigeria is partnering with the Rotary club of Mansfield, Ohio USA to support the tuition of an African Medical Physics PhD student. We seek to foster local connections between the student and Rotary.

The student should demonstrate a commitment to the Rotary motto, "Service above self," which reminds us of our duty to help others before we help ourselves. Additionally, the student should have economic need for assistance and strong scholarship potential. These three criteria will be evaluated and the awardee will be selected based on their demonstrated merit.



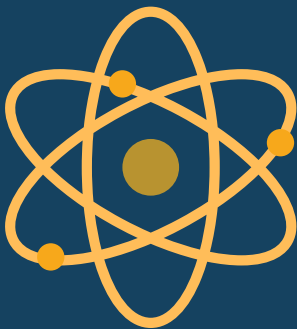


ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- First degree in Physics or Engineering with at least a second class
- Must be enrolled in a PhD program in a Nigerian university or at least be in possession of an admission letter.
- Must be able to demonstrate economic need

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Degree certificates (bachelor and master)
- Master's degree transcript
- One page research proposal
- Evidence of PhD admission in a Nigerian university



IMPORTANT DATES

- Deadline for submission of applications: June 30
- Notification of selected candidates for interviews by email: July 15
- Interviews: Between July 18 - July 29
- Final notification of awards: August 5
