Criteria
Communicator and Collaborator
Communicate clearly, sensitively, and effectively with the patient, and their family/carers.
Display professionalism when developing professional relationships that facilitate gathering and sharing of essential information, to provide effective health care.
Collaborate professionally with health practitioners.
Collaborate with healthcare professionals to provide safe, high-quality patient centred care.
Perform accurate and relevant documentation of patient treatment and care plans.
Leader and Health Advocate
Contribute to high-quality health care systems and take responsibility for the delivery of excellent patient care.
Understand and comply with ethical and professional clinical practice, consistent with relevant legislation and regulatory requirements.
Work with patients and their families to provide treatment and examination that is fostered in respect, dignity, and care for the individual and their specific needs.
Contribute to improving health outcomes in patient populations.
Demonstrate professional responsibility and accountability in practice.
Understand and advocate for the needs of the patient, and their family/carers.
Contribute to the continued development and progress of the medical physics profession.
